



# USAWA KWA WOTE PARTY

## THE CODE OF CONDUCT OF THE USAWA KWA WOTE PARTY 2021

1. Any member or official of any organ of the Party must adhere to the Party Code of Conduct.
2. The Party Code of Conduct prohibits party Members or Officials from:
  - a) Getting involved in violence as a means of promoting their individual or party position on any political matter
  - b) Tampering with Party records, documents or accounts.
  - c) Campaigning for or canvassing for votes for a person vying for election in opposition to a candidate of the Usawa.
  - d) Joining or supporting a political organization or party other than the Usawa or a party in coalition or alliance with the Usawa.
  - e) Prejudicing the integrity or repute of the Party, its personnel or its operational capacity by impeding the activities of the Party or creating division within its ranks or membership.
  - f) Failing to pay their subscriptions.
  - g) Misappropriating the funds of the Party or destroying its properties
  - h) Abusing elected or employed officers of the Party or in Government to obtain any direct or indirect undue advantage or enrichment
  - i) Breaching the peace through disorderly behavior.
  - j) Deliberately disrupting meetings or otherwise interfering with the orderly functioning of the Party; and
  - k) Doing or failing to do any other thing that undermine the aims or objectives of the Usawa or otherwise contravenes the Party's rules or regulations made under this Constitution.
3. Disciplinary proceedings against a member shall be instituted for violations of the Usawa's Codes of Conduct.
4. The NEC and National Disciplinary Committee as established under the Party Constitution shall have the power to receive, hear and determine all cases relating to violation of the Party's Code Conduct.
5. The NEC and National Disciplinary Committee as established under the Party Constitution shall continuously monitor adherence of all party members to the Party's Code Conduct.
